2022 LENTEN OFFERING RECIPIENTS

Our Missions Committee has chosen the following to be recipients of this year's Lenten offering:

*Mathew 25 is a local non-profit that exists to strengthen core neighborhoods on CR's west side, partnering with them in Neighborhood Building, Youth Development and Cultivating Hope. LL will again partner with Matt25 during Transform Week in late June. Matt25 also aims to raise 1.4 million to invest in and reinvigorate the Time Check neighborhood.

*UMCOR responds to natural or civil disasters of such magnitude that they overwhelm a community's ability to recover on its own. When responding to a disaster in the U.S. or around the world, UMCOR provides training, financial assistance, expertise, and community rebuilding. With climate change we have recently seen more natural disasters such as fires, tornados, and other severe weather.

*Green Square Meals has been serving Cedar Rapids area for 35 years with a free hot meal to those in need. It is the only evening meal program in Cedar Rapids. They currently serve about 30,000 meals a year. Their doors are open to any person in need of a good hot meal. The program depends on donations of food, money, and volunteers who prepare and serve meals.

*Water@Work provides clean water in the Dominican Republic. Nearly a million people in the D.R. still do not have clean water. Contributions to W@W provide funds for construction of water distribution plants that are locally run. Water is sold at a minimal profit to the people. The profits will cover the costs of plant maintenance and to pour back into the communities.
