<u>Hillcrest Family Services of Dubuque</u> is a place people come for help, guidance, and compassion. Folks leaving Hillcrest feel better physically through their Health Services, and troubled youth build confidence through the foster group care programs. At Hillcrest the homeless gain hope, and those wanting a family gain a promise. Hillcrest builds character in adults who have lost their dignity, and adds stability to the lives of families in need of mentoring. (12/3)

Nourished is a growing new community that strives to be a place to grow relationships that feed the soul. This is done through two experiments: a spiritual community and a gluten free bakery. Studies show that nearly 30% of the population is gluten free by choice or medical diagnosis, but for many in this population there are few, if any, options in restaurants and coffee shops. On the flip side, there are many who identify as spiritual but not religious, have religious trauma, or are un-attracted to the inherited church.
